

PSP Team Based Care Flexible Learning Opportunities

The Practice Support Program offers a series of flexible learning opportunities which help primary care providers and practice teams develop competencies key to successful team based care (TBC) in practice, as outlined in the National Interprofessional Competency Framework (www.cihc.ca).

The learning series is an opportunity to delve into key components of team based care as a team, and have protected time to make practice improvements together. Interprofessional teams are encouraged to participate in sessions together, and all team members who support the completion of the QI Cycle can be compensated for their time contributing (in accordance with PSP's QI Cycle compensation policy).

The series offers a flexible approach to PSP learning sessions, providing a tailored learning experience for participants, and emphasizing priority learning needs. You can choose to focus on specific topics based on your current practice needs. You can choose to participate in the full series if desired, but this is not required.
